

A Capitol Hill Faith Forum

Dr. Mark Braverman, an outspoken advocate of Peace and Reconciliation in the Middle East, is the author of <u>Fatal Embrace: Christian, Jews and the</u> <u>Search for Peace in the Holy Land.</u> He is in demand as a presenter, and recently represented the U.S. in a "Southern Africa-Palestine Kairos Encounter". This conference involved theologians, pastors and lay people from South Africa, Palestine and Europe who shared learnings and experiences related to the impact of a Kairos document in South Africa in the 1980's and recently in Palestine, and explored implications for a global movement in advocacy of the Kairos-Palestine Document. Dr. Braverman's presentation will be followed by facilitated discussion.
