In his writing and speaking, Braverman focuses on the role of religious beliefs and theology in the current discourse and the function of interfaith relations in the current search for a peaceful resolution of the conflict. He has been closely involved in the growth of the international church movement for a just and lasting peace for Israelis and Palestinians. Braverman serves on the advisory board of Friends of Sabeel North America and is a member of Jewish Voice for Peace. He is a cofounder of Friends of Tent of Nations North America, a nonprofit dedicated to supporting Palestinian land rights in historic Palestine. He currently serves as Executive Director for Kairos USA. a movement to unify and mobilize American Christians to take a prophetic stance for a just peace in Israel and Palestine.
